MAJOR DUTIES

The Augusta Technical College Audio Visual Technician performs a variety of tasks and is responsible for general operation and maintaining the theater control booth systems, as well as coordinating and assisting with duties related to the events booked at the facility. Their duties include event set up and strike, troubleshooting, preventive maintenance, interaction with clients/users/guests, and other control booth related tasks. Shifts will vary depending on event schedules and will often include evenings, late nights/early mornings, and weekends. Some events will require out-of-theatre set-ups.

COMPETENCIES

Experience must include the operation, use, and care of audio/visual equipment such as speakers, amplifiers, mixers, sound controller boards, wired and wireless microphones, recording or playback devices, live stream output, multi remote camera operation, video monitors, control room, theater lighting, theater lighting systems, audio/video editing software; operating professional video cameras in the production of different types of video content or live events.

Computer software operation may include YouTube, OSB, Facebook Live, Microsoft Office Suite, PowerPoint, ProPresenter 1, Blackmagic Huddle Cam, Blackmagic Hyperdeck Switch, Stage Lighting System Control Software and other software as needed.

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MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

An Associate Degree and must have two (2) years' general control booth experience including equipment maintenance. They must be willing to assist and/or train other staff in skilled repair and maintenance tasks. A valid driver's license/good driving records and dependable transportation.

The selected candidate may be subject to emergency calls and various shifts.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Indoors—250 seat theatre hall, stage, office, control rooms, backstage, lobby areas; Moderate to extreme heights on ladders, electrical and mechanical hazards; requires extensive walking, carrying, dragging, holding, pulling, pushing, lifting, kneeling, bending, twisting body, walking, reaching, and squatting; may be required to lift up to 50 pounds.
