A review of completed application packets may begin upon receipt. Interviews of qualified candidates may begin following review; the position may close at any time after May 11, 2026 based on a candidate selection.

Position Summary:

Provides education and/or training support to CGTC faculty and college students. Serves as on-site monitor/proctor for Paramedic Technology (EMSP) classes. Provides oversight to program students in the instructor's absence by performing the following task(s): prepare lab materials and maintain order and cleanliness in the lab environment, use observational skills to remain aware of changes in the behavior and physical condition of students, duties as assigned. Evaluates students' progress in attaining goals and objectives. The instructor must possess the ability to teach all phases of the curriculum. Demonstrates the use of appropriate teaching techniques; use of appropriate testing and grading procedures including proper maintenance of grade books and any other record-keeping required; effective use of oral and written communication skills; and knowledge of current in-field procedures. Follows approved course syllabus. Maintain program requirements, attend/complete all professional development training; meet with students and college personnel to discuss students' instructional programs and other issues. Evaluates student progress in attaining goals and objectives. Completes all reports, records and invoices in a timely manner and maintains accurate inventory of all assigned properties. Maintain records in the Georgia EMS License Management System as required by the Georgia Office of EMS and Trauma. Maintain qualifications for employment as described by the Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) Policy Manual and accreditation standards. Follows rules and regulations as described by the TCSG Policy Manual and other policies and procedures established by the institution. Position may involve teaching traditional day and/or evening classes or online classes and will require travel within the college's service area and additional travel as needed.

Location/Schedule:

Working location is Monroe County College and Career Academy. Class times are projected to be scheduled Monday through Friday for up to 2 hours per day and will follow the College and Career Academy academic calendar. The projected Fall schedule is provided below, the actual class times may vary each academic term based on the course scheduling:

- EMSP 1211 Monday to Friday, 9:45 a.m. to 11:15am

Minimum Qualifications: *Must upload transcripts which show conferred educational degrees and document qualifications in the employment history:*

- Documented current licensure as a Georgia AEMT, Cardiac Technician or Paramedic
- Documented active license as a Georgia EMS Instructor/Coordinator (EMT) as listed on the Georgia Department of Public Health Office of EMS and Trauma website <https://dph.georgia.gov/EMS/ems-licensure/ems-instructor-licensure> **OR** achieve EMS Instructor/Coordinator license within 3 months of hire.
- Documented BCLS certification.
- At least 18 months of documented experience in field.

Preferred Qualifications, in addition to the minimum qualifications: *Preference may be given to applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum qualifications, provide transcripts of conferred degrees and demonstrate in the employment history possession of one or more of the following:*

- Minimum of an earned Associate's degree in Paramedicine, Emergency Management, Healthcare management or closely related field from an institution that is accredited by an institutional accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education
- Documented teaching experience at the post-secondary level.
- Specialty provider and/or instructor certifications in fire and emergency related specialties are preferred; active participation in appropriate professional/occupational organizations; excellent human relations skills; computer skills and experience.
- Documented experience in BANNER, ANGEL/Blackboard and MS Office.

Salary / Benefits:

This position is paid a set fee per course rate based on a \$24-\$26 gross hourly rate per contact hour depending on earned degree. May include additional stipends for student contact hours, orientation and training, course development, etc. Adjunct positions are temporary, time-limited appointments encompassing a single academic term or period and do not imply or suggest a continuance of employment or a promise of future full-time employment. CGTC is a member of Teachers Retirement System of Georgia (TRS) and Employees Retirement System of Georgia (ERS). Adjunct positions are not eligible for TRS or ERS retirement benefits, state insurance, leave or holiday pay.

Application Procedure:

Applicants are required to complete the employment application in full and provide supporting documentation by the stated closing deadline for the position. GCTC does not accept mailed, faxed, or hand-delivered applications.

Applicants who complete the application procedure will be evaluated for meeting the position requirements based on the published job responsibilities, meeting the minimum and preferred qualifications based on the educational history, employment skills presented under job duties in the application system against the published job announcement. A completed application packet consists of the following:

1. A completed CGTC electronic application in the CGTC application portal. Resumes are not accepted in lieu of the CGTC electronic application. If submitted as supporting documentation it

will not be considered in the applicant evaluation.

2. Postsecondary transcripts that demonstrate the conferral of the degree, if applicable, and demonstrates the applicant meets the educational minimum requirements and, if applicable, the preferred educational requirements (*grade reports and diploma copies are not accepted in lieu of transcripts*)
3. Positions requiring a High School Diploma or GED as a minimum qualification do not have to submit an HSD/GED transcript documentation as part of the application process.
4. Non-photo license(s) and/or certification(s) which fulfill the minimum, and if applicable the preferred qualifications stated in the job announcement.

Incomplete application packets at the time of the position closing may not be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain and upload the application documentation by the stated deadline.
